Petitioners seek necessary correction in the house number as well as father's name of petitioner No.2.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, House No.5646 be read in place of House No.4646 and name of father of petitioner No.2 be read as Partap Singh.

Application stands disposed of.

Amended memorandum of parties is taken on record.

Main case

Petitioners seek issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 3 for granting protection qua their lives and liberty from being invaded by their parents and family members.

Petitioners are major and have solemnized their marriage on 18.01.2017 and they feel reasonable apprehension from their relatives as they have solemnized the marriage against their wishes. Petitioners have not filed any representation to the police.

Without commenting upon anything on majority and validity of marriage, at this stage, this petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to treat the petition itself as a representation and decide the same in accordance with law.

If the respondent No.2 feels that there is a possible threat perception qua lives and liberty of the petitioners, then adequate security may be granted to them, provided they are not involved in any other case.

The authority shall be at liberty to device its own mechanism to ascertain the threat perception of the petitioners.
