The petitioners are seeking quashing of the order dated 29.09.2016 whereby non-bailable warrants for securing the presence of the petitioner have been issued as well as order dated 21.11.2016 vide which the proceedings against the petitioner for declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender have been issued in FIR No.25 dated 05.02.2016 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 541 IPC, Police Station Phillaur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was earlier working in Spain and due to injuries sustained in an accident in Spain, he could not appear before the trial Court and, therefore, the impugned orders were passed.

Learned counsel further contends that in pursuance of the order passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court on 23.01.2017, father of the petitioner had deposited an amount of ₹10,000/- as costs of proceedings with the trial Court. The petitioner had also surrendered before the trial Court on 20.03.2017 and he has also been granted permission to go abroad by the trial Court vide order dated 08.08.2017.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially in view of the fact that the petitioner had surrendered before the trial Court, this petition has been rendered infructuous and stands disposed of accordingly.
