Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to look into the progress of FIR No.27 got registered by the petitioner on 09.04.2016 for the offences under Sections 447/448/427/506/148/149 IPC in Police Station Kathu Nangal, Amritsar Rural.

In respect of aforesaid case, a detailed inquiry was conducted by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Majitha, wherein it was found that the accused persons have not been arrested in the case so far and the SHO of the police station was directed to arrest the accused persons quickly and present the challan in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite aforesaid inquiry and directions vide report dated 11.10.2016, respondent No.3 has not acted in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rimplejeet Kaur, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State. Let 3 copies of the petition be supplied to learned State Counsel during course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of calling upon reply.

At this stage, this petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to look into the matter independently without being influenced by any of the pleadings made in the petition and have independent assessment of fact and pass appropriate order in accordance with law. Needful be done within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
