Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.109 dated 01.08.2012 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 354, 294, 148, 149, 120-B, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Sohana, Tehsil and District SAS Nagar (Mohali), on the basis of compromise dated 29.03.2017 (Annexure-P3) and affidavits Annexure-P4 and P5.

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 02.06.2017 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court on 10.07.2017 to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mohali on 31.08.2017 and got recorded their statements for compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide letter bearing No.199 dated 04.09.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar vide Endst. No.9013 dated 04.09.2017.

According to the report of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mohali, the compromise between the parties is genuine and without any pressure or coercion.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.109, is hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
