Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.33 dated 30.03.2017 registered under Sections 406/498-A of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Women, District Ludhiana, on the basis of compromise dated 16.05.2017 (Annexure-P2).

Vide order dated 05.07.2017 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate on 18.07.2017 or any other date fixed by it, for recording of their statements for compromise with a direction to the Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana on 22.08.2017 and got recorded their statements for compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has

also been received vide letter bearing No.676 dated 09.09.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana vide letter bearing No.1878/EC dated 11.09.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, the compromise between the parties is genuine and without any pressure from any corner and coercion.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.33, is hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
