Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are in custody since August 2016, with even the charges not framed so far.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, admits to the aforesaid fact and on query submits that 23 prosecution witnesses are to be examined as yet.

In view of the aforesaid and seeing that the petitioners are admitted to be residents of District Fazilka, who have been in custody for the past 6 months with the trial being nowhere near conclusion as yet, also looking at the nature of the offence alleged to have been committed, I consider it appropriate to admit the petitioners to bail upon their furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
