Counsel for the State has apprised that offence punishable under Section 224 of the Indian Penal Code has been deleted.

Counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners have already joined investigation in compliance with interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 22.06.2016. It has further been submitted that the petitioners are ready to face the proceedings in accordance with law.

Counsel for the State has conceded to the position.

Counsel for the complainant would submit that in view of gravity of the allegations, the petitioners are not entitled to bail in anticipation of arrest.

As custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required and no recovery is to be effected coupled with the factum that they have already

joined investigation, without commenting upon the merits of the case, interim bail granted to the petitioners is made absolute subject to conditions incorporated in order dated 22.06.2016.
