The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.40 dated 23.2.2017 under Sections 22 of NDPS Act, Police Station Maloya, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioner and her family members are involved in selling liquor and also the contraband articles. Insofar as the present petitioner is concerned, there is no other case against her under the NDPS Act, though there are two cases under the Excise Act. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the daughter aged about 10 years is alone at the house.

In the light of the above facts, I am inclined to grant regular bail to the petitioner on furnishing an undertaking on affidavit that she would not indulge in any type of offence and would also submit a copy of the affidavit to the concerned police station.

In that view of the matter, I make the following order:-

ORDER

- (i) CRM-M-20846 of 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner shall file an affidavit within two weeks from the date of her release that she will not commit such type of offence again.
- (iv) The State will be at liberty to apply for cancellation of bail in case of any further commission of such type of offence by the petitioner.
