ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.10 dated 21.01.2017, under Sections 420, 467, 468 & 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Rureke Kalan, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner (who was working as Patwari) are that he forged the signatures of CRO and Kanungo while making entries in mutation. He further contends that mutation entries by the petitioner per se are not wrong or illegal and no individual has come forward to lodge the complaint in this regard.

This Court, by the order dated 28.07.2017, had directed the petitioner to join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 28.07.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
