Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.15 dated 15.01.2017 registered under Sections 279, 337, 338 and 304-A of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar, on the basis of compromise dated 28.02.2017 (Annexure-P2).

Vide order dated 21.09.2017 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 25.10.2017 for recording their statements with a direction to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to furnish a report qua veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Sub

Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Kharar and got recorded their statements.

Report from the concerned Magistrate has been received vide letter bearing No.440 dated 07.11.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar vide Endst. No.11140 dated 08.11.2017.

According to the report of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Kharar, the compromise is genuine, without any threat, coercion or undue influence, voluntarily and is out of free will of the parties.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.15, is quashed qua the petitioner.
