The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.21 dated 19.05.2017 registered under Section 61 (mentioned as 61/1/14 in the impugned order) of the Punjab Excise Act, at Police Station Lakhewali, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was granted interim bail by this court vide order dated 02.06.2017.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custody is not required.

Learned counsel for the petitioner makes a statement that the petitioner will file an undertaking that he would not indulge in any type of offence and would also submit a copy of the affidavit to the concerned Police Station.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is ready to give undertaking on affidavit as stated above, I am inclined to make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) Interim order dated 02.06.2017 is made absolute.
- (ii) The CRL. MISC. No.M-20923 OF 2017 is allowed, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall file an affidavit within two weeks from today that he will not commit any type of offence again and would also submit a copy of the affidavit to the concerned Police Station as aforesaid.
