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The matter was settled between the parties vide order of this Court dated 03.08.2017. Pursuant to that order, New India Assurance Company Limited has brought a crossed-cheque of HDFC Bank, 401-402, Model Town Delhi Road Rohtak -124001, Haryana RTGS/NEFT IFSC : HDFC0000176 bearing No.007674 dated 06.09.2017 for ₹2,40,000/- (₹ Two Lac Forty Thousand Only) in favour of Smt.Bedo Devi wd/o Sh.Rajender Singh - appellant No.1, as per statement of learned counsel for the appellants. However, it has been stated by learned counsel for the appellants that he is not in contact with the appellants and that the amount be ordered to be deposited with the MACT.

Hence, the cheque, which was brought by learned counsel and representatives of the Insurance Company, has been returned to the Insurance Company with a direction that the amount be deposited with the MACT, Rohtak, within two months in favour of appellant No.1 – Bedo Devi wd/o Sh.Rajender Singh, failing which, interest @ 9% shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order.

The appeal is disposed of accordingly.
