Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No.177 dated 13.06.2016 under Sections 364-A, 120-B and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Chand Hat, District Palwal.

The FIR came to be registered at the instance of Moharan @ Mohana wife of Mohender. Complainant alleged that her son Ravi had gone to village Badhram to her brother Gangalal 4-5 days ago. On 12.06.2016, she received a call that she should go to village Sahupura with an amount of Rs.50,000/-, otherwise her son would be killed. She went to village Badhram and informed her brother. Dheeraj who is son of her elder brother Budh Singh was successful in contacting the kidnappers on telephone. The name of Rahul came to fore

who asked him to bring the amount in question.

Learned counsel for the petitioner by relying upon testimonies of PW3 Dheeraj, PW4 Ravi and PW5 Mohran @ Mohna (complainant) submits that the material witnesses have become hostile and have not supported the prosecution case. They have been cross-examined also but nothing incriminating could come on record.

Co-accused Rahul has already been granted regular bail by the trial Court.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Surinder Singh is not in a position to rebut the aforesaid contention of learned counsel for the petitioner.

Petitioner is in custody since 13.06.2016.

Without embarking upon merits of the case, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
