The petitioners have filed these petitions under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.46 dated 28.01.2017 registered under Section 409 and 420 IPC at Police Station Shahabad, District Kurukshetra.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

This Court has granted interim bail to both the petitioners vide separate orders dated 02.06.2017 and 09.06.2017 passed in CRM-M-20951-2017 and CRM-21631-2017, respectively.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to interim order of this Court the petitioners have appeared before the trial Court and furnished their bail bonds and are admitted to bail. In support of this contention learned counsel for the petitioners has placed on record order dated 05.08.2017 passed by the trial Court. The same is taken on record.

In that view of the matter, interim order dated 02.06.2017 passed in CRM-M-20951-2017 and interim order dated 09.06.2017 passed in CRM-21631-2017, both are made absolute.
