Petitioner is seeking direction to the official respondents to conduct fair and impartial enquiry in FIR No.139 dated 26.03.2017, under Sections 323, 328, 506, 377 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station, City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Petitioner is mother-in-law of complainant-Pooja (respondent No.4), whose marriage was solemnized with Vikrant (son of petitioner). After marriage, she has got registered the aforesaid FIR against her in-laws.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that after registration of the FIR, the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by the Court. He further states that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case, therefore, she is seeking fair and impartial investigation of the case. With regard to her grievance, the petitioner made a representation/application dated 19.04.2017 (Annexure P-4) to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar-respondent No.2, but to no avail.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar-respondent No.2 to look into the application/representation dated 19.04.2017 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate action in accordance with law.
