Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 regarding fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.25 dated 10.04.2017 registered under Sections 436 and 148 IPC at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga.

In pursuance to the notice of motion order passed by this Court, reply by way of affidavit of Shubeg Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 filed in the Court is taken on record.

As per the affidavit, during the investigation which is marked to the deponent – Deputy Superintendent of Police, Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga, offence under Section 452 IPC has already been added and the investigation is pending which is likely to be concluded.
