ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.90 dated 04.08.2016 under Sections 307, 341, 324, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Passiana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no injury has been attributed to the petitioner and the only allegation in the FIR against the petitioner is that he had raised a lalkara. He further contends that the petitioner is 67 years of age and has put in over 5 months in custody.

Therefore, as the petitioner who is 67 years of age is attributed only lalkara and is in custody for over 5 months, I deem it to be a fit case to grant him the concession of regular bail.

The petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. He shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
