Petitioner-Ved Parkash Gupta has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.451 dated 30.12.2016, registered at Police Station Baldev Nagar Ambala, under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant has also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the allegations, the petitioner alongwith co-accused received ₹2,70,000/- to send Jasbir Kumar abroad,

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but he was not sent. As per the FIR and prosecution version, ₹1,52,000/- have been deposited in the account of the Firm of the petitioner. There is also allegation that Visa documents provided by the petitioner were found to be forged.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence; in view of serious allegations levelled against the petitioner and in view of the facts and circumstances of the present case, I find that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
