HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition for grant of bail to Pardeep and Sanjay in case FIR No.66 dated 19.3.2017 under Sections 153A(i)(ii), 153B(iii), 504 IPC and Section 67 of the I.T.Act, registered at Police Station Agroha, District Hisar. Subsequently, Sections 506, 509 and 294 IPC were also added in the FIR.

The FIR has been registered on the complaint of one Pardeep son of Mahabir alleging that some inhabitants of the village have given threat of life to his family and they have prepared an obscene video and circulated the same on whatsapp and facebook, wherein, they have directly commented on his cousin, namely Miss Manju and Niece Miss Sanju. They also used obscene words about both of them. The names of accused Pardeep son of Ishwar, Pardeep son of Mahender, Sanjay son of Jagpal, Manjit son of Mahabir, Davender son of Om Parkash and Ajay alias Joni son of Ramesh Kumar were disclosed in the complaint.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioners states that they are behind the bars since 28.3.2017 and investigation has already been completed by the police and challan presented to Court. He further states that co-accused Ajay, Pardeep son of Ishwar, Devender and Manjeet have already been admitted to bail by the Sessions Court.

In the circumstances, the petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on bail, subject to their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Hisar.
