This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.194 dated 17.04.2017 registered under Sections 18 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is no cogent witness of the incident. The quantity of the contraband recovered from the petitioner was 650 grams of opium, which is non-commercial quantity and the petitioner is in custody since 17.04.2017.

Learned State counsel has not been able to controvert the aforesaid facts.

Having heard counsel for the parties, this Court is of the view that the prayer made in the present petition merits acceptance.

Without making any observations on merits and keeping in view the quantity of contraband recovered from the petitioner, he is held entitled to the benefit of bail. Petitioner, Manpreet Singh @ Lovely be

enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate,
Kurukshetra.
