This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 513 dated 20.11.2016, under Section 304-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Gannaur, District Sonapat.

It is contended by the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and he is in custody since 30.11.2016. It is also contended that the statement of the complainant has been recorded and the trial is likely to take some time.

Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana, has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested the bail application. She submits that out of total 16 witnesses, statements of four witnesses have been recorded so far.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view

the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 30.11.2016; statement of the complainant has been recorded and that the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
