Petitioners have approached this Court with an assertion that their life and liberty is in danger from respondents 4 to 7.

Mr. S.K. Gupta, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.4 and he stated that the said respondent-Shivinder Singh son of Gohar Singh, who is father of petitioner No.1, wanted to interact and talk to petitioner No.1. This request of the counsel for respondent No.4 was accepted and respondent No.4 was permitted to talk to his daughter in Court. After meeting her daughter and talking to her, he states that he has no objection in case the petitioners have already got married and is further ready to perform all rites.

In view of the above, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Jagraon-respondent No.2, to consider the representation dated 01.06.2017 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
