[1]. The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 14, dated February 13, 2017, registered under Sections 22/25/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station City Mansa, District Mansa.

[2]. Custody certificate of the petitioner is filed. Be taken on record.

[3]. Heard both sides.

[4]. It transpires that recovery of 12 vials of Corex Syrup, weighing 1200 ml. in all, was effected from the petitioner, which is marginally above

the commercial quantity. All other accused persons in the case have already been granted bail.

[5]. Admittedly, the petitioner has not been convicted in any similar case earlier, although one matter arising out of F.I.R. No. 76, dated September 17, 2014, is still stated to be pending trial.

[6]. In the given circumstances, considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, namely Jatinder Kumar @ Tina s/o Om Parkash, in this case, he is directed to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court, subject to the compliance of the conditions, if any, imposed by the Ld. Trial Court.

[5]. The petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
