ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in complaint No.364 dated 11.12.2009 (Annexure P-1), under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), which is pending in the Court of SDJM, Rajpura, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is willing to surrender before the trial Court and file an application for regular bail, which may be decided on the same day as the offence under Section 138 of the Act is bailable. He further states that the petitioner had earlier been granted interim bail. However, he could not appear before the trial Court on one date as he was confined in another case. He undertakes that the petitioner shall, henceforth, keep appearing before the trial Court as and when called upon to do so.

The petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and move an application for regular bail. The trial Court shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law, preferably on the same day.
