Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner-Pardeep Kumar in case registered by way of FIR No.02 dated 5th January, 2017 at Police Station Khizrabad, District Yamuna Nagar under Sections 15, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of orders of interim bail dated 7th February, 2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State Counsel on instructions from S.I. Dharam Singh, Police Station CIA-2, Yamuna Nagar who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated

7th February, 2017 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner(s) will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
