Through these two petitions under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.60 dated 07.08.2005 under Sections 323, 326, 148 and 149 I.P.C. and Cross Case registered vide D.D.R. No.20 dated 07.08.2005 under Sections 325, 323, 193, 148 and 149 pertaining to Police Station Sehna, District Barnala, on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 29.11.2016 passed in CRM-M-41330-2016, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Barnala and got recorded their statements for compromise. Report bearing No.76 dated 13.03.2017 from the concerned Magistrate duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Barnala vide Endst. No.1361/EB dated 15.03.2017 has also been received.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Barnala, the compromise between the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.60 and Cross Case registered vide DDR No.20, are hereby quashed.

Petitions are disposed of accordingly.
