Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon two judgments of coordinate Benches of this Court, in *Ram Niwas Vs. State of Haryana, 2001 (1) RCR(Criminal) 3* and *Sandeep Sahni Vs. State of Punjab, 2006 (2) RCR (Criminal) 546*. However, looking at the fact that the petitioner is attributed a role of raising a *lalkara*, i.e. instigating all his co-accused to attack the victims while they were already admitted in hospital, after having initially attacked them once, I am not inclined to grant pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.

However, nothing stated hereinabove shall be taken as a comment on the merits of the case itself but only in context of the petition seeking anticipatory bail.
