The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.11 dated 04.02.2016 registered under Section 306 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station GRP, District Ambala Cantt..

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Pursuant to the secret information, the FIR was registered and thereafter raid was conducted. According to the prosecution, the other persons as well as the petitioner were found in possession of rifles and, therefore there is a reason to believe that the petitioner was also the person who had designed to commit robbery by use of the weapons.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Kuldeep Singh submits that there is no other case of similar type against the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence, I make the following order:

**ORDER**

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-22074 OF 2016 is allowed
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
