AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

The present petition has been preferred by the petitioner for grant of regular bail. Petitioner was arrested in this case on 18.04.2017. As per the FIR, the allegations against the petitioner are that he has used a weapon like a sword, which has hit the right and left arms at the forward side of the petitioner, which injuries have been found to be simple. Apart from that, the little finger of the right hand is stated to have been injured, on which, an operation was carried out and the complainant has now recovered. Counsel contends that the challan has been presented in Court and even the charges have been framed. Counsel contends that the trial is not likely to be concluded soon and further continuation of the petitioner in prison would not serve any useful purpose. He, therefore, prays for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Having considered the submissions made by the counsel for the

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petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 18.04.2017 as well as the fact that the complainant has now recovered, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ambala.
