In FIR No.103 dated 15.10.2015, under Sections 324, 323, 379, 341, 506, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail. This Court had made an order dated 06.06.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
