The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.0897 dated 29.12.2015, under Sections 420,467,468,471,120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station DLF, Sector 29, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is 72 years old Ex-serviceman, who is suffering from Chronic Obstructive Airways Disease and Post Viral Orthralgia with stiff back. He has furnished a copy of the Medical Certificate, which is taken on record. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for over 10 months and the similarly situated co-accused, namely, Rajesh Kumar and Vedpal were granted anticipatory bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, Gurgaon.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that out of nine prosecution witnesses, six have been examined in the case.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner

and keeping in view that the petitioner is 72 years old Ex-serviceman suffering from various ailments, I deem it to be a fit case to grant him the concession of regular bail. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Prem Singh, is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
