It is also noted that on 10.1.2017, none appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Today also, none appears on behalf of the petitioner.

In order to give, one more opportunity, list this matter on 17.2.2017.

If necessary steps to serve respondents No.9 to 11 is not taken before the next date of hearing, petition would be dismissed for non prosecution.”

Thereafter, one more opportunity was given on 15.03.2017. Despite that today none appears even though matter called twice.

Hence, CWP stands dismissed for non-prosecution.
