The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 109, dated 16.05.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Tanda, Distirct Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had caused injury on the back of the complainant with a Dang. Learned counsel further contends that in pursuance to the order dated 07.06.2017 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and undertakes to make himself available in the investigation, as and when required to do so.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has indeed joined the investigation.

Therefore, as the injury attributed to the petitioner is on the back of the complainant and he has joined investigation in terms of the order of a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the order dated 07.06.2017 is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
