The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.290 dated 25.03.2017, under Sections 498-A, 323, 506, 406, 328, 34 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 406 and 506 of IPC added subsequently), registered at Police Station Civil Lines Hisar.

By order dated 06.06.2017, arrest of the petitioner, who is the husband of the complainant, was stayed and he was directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on the

direction of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. It is also contended that in fact, the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Learned AAG Haryana for the respondent-State, on instructions from ASI Vijay Kumar, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for the custodial interrogation, while further submitting that in fact, the matter has been compromised between the parties.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 06.06.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
