Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.103 dated 15.05.2017 registered under Sections 420/120-B IPC at Police Station Zira, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present FIR. He further contends that the petitioners have not cheated or played any fraud with complainant party nor they had taken any money or documents from them.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and have gone through the case file.

In brief, allegation against the petitioners is for cheating on the name of sending abroad. The petitioners have taken money from the complainant party to send them abroad. But they neither sent them abroad nor returned their money and when the complainant party demanded their money from them then they have misbehaved with them.

In view of above, no case is made out to grant concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. This Court feels that it is a fit case where custodial interrogation of the petitioners is required to unearth the

truth. This petition is accordingly dismissed.
