Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.192 dated 26.09.2016 under Sections 25/27 Arms Act registered at Police Station City South Moga.

Vide order dated 07.06.2017, the petitioner was granted *ad interim* bail and was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to aforesaid order of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Santokh Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid facts.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 07.06.2017 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
