Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Nirmal Singh, Police Station Phase 11, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) submits that complainant Kuldeep Singh had given an affidavit regarding the matter having been settled with the petitioner and in compliance of order dated 16.6.2017 the petitioner-Bhupinder Singh has since joined the investigation and that nothing is to be recovered from him and has not opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner.

Though learned counsel for the complainant has tried to oppose the bail but could not convince this Court as to how there is reversal of the

stand of the complainant with regard to the compromise effected between him and the petitioner.

In view of the stand of State counsel, ad interim order dated 16.6.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

The petition stands disposed off.
