AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was arrested on 15th March, 2017. He contends that a *lalkara* has been attributed to the petitioner and apart from that, no other overt act has been alleged to have been committed by him. Learned counsel further contends that the challan has already been presented and the case is now listed for hearing on 1st July, 2017, for framing of charges.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Ajaib Singh, Police Station Joga, District Mansa, states that the assertions of the learned counsel for the petitioner is correct.

Keeping in view the allegations made against the petitioner and that the trial is not likely to conclude soon, petitioner is admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Mansa.
