The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.54, dated 28.04.2017, under Sections 326/325/324/427/148/149/506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

During the course of arguments, it stands conceded that the injury suffered by the complainant/injured, Sangha Singh and on his leg has been specifically attributed to the present petitioner on account of a *kirpan* blow and which has attracted offence under Section 326 IPC.

In the light of grievous injury inflicted by the petitioner and which finds corroboration from the medical record, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner, concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition is dismissed.
