Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.66 dated 03.05.2015 under Sections 388, 389, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.1, Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 08.06.2017 passed by this Court, petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and she has been admitted on bail. Petitioner undertakes that she will appear before the trial Court regularly.

In compliance of aforesaid order dated 08.06.2017, learned District & Sessions Judge, Pathankot has forwarded his report which is based on the report received from concerned officers i.e. Shri Rakesh Kumar Sharma, Additional District & Sessions Judge, Pathankot and

Shri Kewal Krishan, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Pathankot.

The said report suggests that inadvertently the order of case titled as “State Versus Rajiv Kumar” was uploaded in CIS record of case titled as “State Versus Anita Rani”. Now that mistake has been rectified.

In view of the fact the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been admitted on bail, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is, accordingly, disposed of.
