Petitioner-Bhupesh Goyal has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.382 dated 06.11.2016, registered at Police Station Pundri, under Section 420 IPC and Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version,

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driver and cleaner alongwith TATA 407 were apprehended at the spot. About 1700 litres kerosene oil which was meant for distribution through ration-depots to the consumers, was found loaded in the said vehicle for selling somewhere else. As per the prosecution version, kerosene oil was to be supplied to the present petitioner. The present petitioner is the mastermind of this case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in this petition, the same is dismissed.
