On the statement of Mangal Singh son of Nazar Singh, Chief Security Officer, Best Westeon Merrion Hotel, the instant case vide First Information Report No.166 dated 05.04.2017 under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code was registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar. The complainant stated that he had come to know from some employees of his hotel that Radhe Kishan, who is working as housekeeper in the hotel, has been injured with knife blows by Abhilash, who is also employed in the hotel.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 06.04.2017. The injured after his discharge from the hospital has appeared before the trial Court and his statement stands

recorded.

There was only one injured and as submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner, he has appeared in evidence and his statement has been recorded during the trial. The completion of the trial will still take time and there being no plausible ground to detain the petitioner in custody, he is enlarged on bail on his furnishing bail/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
