Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.91 dated 04.05.2017, under Sections 15/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Kapurthala, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail. This Court had made an order dated 08.06.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has to his credit total 5 criminal cases.

In that view of the matter, the petitioner cannot be allowed the relief of anticipatory bail.

Petition stands dismissed. Interim order dated 08.06.2017 is vacated. Liberty is reserved in favour of the petitioner to apply for regular bail. If such petition for regular bail is filed, the same shall be considered within 15 days from the date of its filing.
