Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.5 dated 4.01.2017 registered under Sections 420/120-B IPC at Police Station Rajasansi, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present FIR. He further contends that the petitioner has not cheated or played any fraud with complainant nor he had taken any money or documents from them.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the case file.

In brief, allegation against the petitioner is for cheating on the name of sending abroad. The petitioner has taken money from the complainant to send her abroad. But he neither sent her abroad nor returned her money and when the complainant demanded her money from him then he has misbehaved with her.

In view of above, no case is made out to grant concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. This Court feels that it is a fit case where custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required to unearth the truth. This petition is accordingly dismissed.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
