This order will dispose of Criminal Miscellaneous No. M-22360 of 2016 filed for quashing of FIR No. 45, dated 02.04.2016 registered under Sections 323,324,341,354,506 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short) at Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana as well as Criminal Miscellaneous No. M-22311 of 2016 filed for quashing of cross-version i.e DDR registered under Sections 323,324,341,354,506 and 149 of the IPC at Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Gurjit Singh, Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana submits that a cancellation report in the above said FIR and the cross-version i.e. DDR was presented and the same have been accepted by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st
