This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 510 dated 24.07.2015, registered under Sections 66E, 67, 67A of the Information Technology Act and Sections 323, 341, 376-D, 384, 506 and 365 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Karnal Sadar, District Karnal.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the statement of the prosecutrix has been recorded. It is also urged that the petitioner was attending school on the date of the occurrence and his school certificate (Annexure P-3) would reflect that he was present in school on 10.07.2014 from 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM when the alleged incident took place. It is also contended that the trial is taking a long time on account of the fact that one of the co-accused is not appearing.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State opposes the grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view the fact that the statement of the prosecutrix has been recorded and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is accepted. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
