The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.119 dated 03.09.2016 for the offence under Sections 376-D, 452, 34 IPC and Section 3 & 4 of POCSO Act registered at Police Station Guruharsahai.

Petitioner is in custody since 27.09.2016. As per allegations in the FIR, Jasveer Kaur daughter of Kundan Singh aged about 17 years was studying in Girl school and Sher Singh son of Amrik Singh of her village was eve-teasing her. She left the school and she was made to sit at home and it was further one month prior to the registration of FIR, petitioner had called her house by saying that she had an urgent work with her. When she went to her house then Major Singh, Baaj Singh and Sher Singh were already present there. She came back on seeing them. Thereafter, they had come to the house of complainant and committed wrong acts with her.

Learned counsel for the State submits that charges are to be framed on today i.e. 28.02.2017. In the present case allegation of rape has

not been attributed to the petitioner.

Keeping in view the above and considering the fact that trial is not likely to mature in near future, petitioner be released on regular bail on furnishing his fresh bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, Ferozepur.
