The present petition has been filed under Section 438
the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 8 dated 23.01.2015
registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station Division
No.3, Jalandhar.

On 08.06.2017 this Court had passed the following
order:-

“It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that the
petitioner is married sister-in-law of the complainant and is resident
of Patiala, whereas the incident is of Jalandhar. He contends that
initially the date was wrongly got noted down by the counsel and,
therefore, on the date fixed, she could not appear, however, on the
subsequent date of hearing, she again could not appear because of
the family circumstances. Counsel contends that the non-
appearance by the petitioner was neither intentional nor deliberate
but it has occurred because of certain circumstances which were

beyond her control. His further submission is that the petitioner undertakes that she would in future appear before the Court on each and every date which is fixed.

Notice of motion for 11.07.2017.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court on 14.06.2017, the date fixed, the Court shall, as an interim measure, admit her to bail to its satisfaction.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 08.06.2017, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and she has been admitted to bail. A photocopy of the order dated 14.06.2017 is taken on record as Mark-A.

In view of above, the order dated 08.06.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing.

The petition is allowed.
