On 24.01.2017, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was a paid director of the company and has already left the company being one of the aggrieved person as his salaries were not paid to him. The petitioner was not connected to the agreement in which the amount of Rs.6,00,000/- was paid by the complainant to the company at the house of Rajesh Kumar. Termination of said agreement has necessary connotation in terms of the arbitration clause and other relevant statute. No complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act was filed by the complainant for dishonouring of third cheque in question.

Notice of motion for 17.03.2017.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 01.02.2017 and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that pursuant to the aforesaid order, the petitioner has already joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Chandgi Ram stated that though the petitioner has joined the investigation but recovery is still to be effected.

Keeping in view the nature of controversy, I deem it appropriate to make the order dated 24.01.2017 as absolute.

Ordered accordingly.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when called to do so and he shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
