ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.66 dated 21.05.2017 under Sections 452/324/323/506/427/148/149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injury attributed to the petitioner is on the elbow of complainant and the FIR was registered after four days of the alleged occurrence. He further contends that in pursuance to the order dated 12.06.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Gurcharan Singh, states that the petitioner has indeed joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the order dated 12.06.2017 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
